Logistics:

Each Agency will present a topic of concern. Facilitators Jerry Gasko, Richard Stalder, and Doug Dretke will lead the discussion periods. Jerry has 40 years of experience in corrections including correctional administration, security, logistics, budgeting, and operations. He retired from the Colorado Department of Corrections as Director of Prisons and is a retired Lt. Col. in the U.S. Army where he was involved in corrections service. Richard Stalder spent more than 30 years in the Louisiana Department of Corrections, working his way through the system from correctional officer to the top position, Secretary. Doug Dretke is the Executive Director of the Correctional Management Institute of Texas. He is a 26-year veteran of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, where he retired as Director of the Correctional Institutions Division.

The training fee of \$380 covers all meals, refreshment breaks, and all training materials. Participants will pay hotel expenses of \$63.95 per day (plus tax) for three (3) nights at the University Hotel. Reservations should be made by March 15, 2010. Each room has two queen-size beds, a refrigerator, etc., and adjoins the training center. Please make arrangements to arrive at Houston's **Bush Intercontinental Airport** (IAH) on Monday, March 29 prior to 3:00pm. A welcome reception and dinner will take place on Monday evening. The training will be held from March 29 to April 1. There will be presentations each day by Wardens, tours of Texas facilities, and delicious meals. Transportation to and from the airport is provided by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Return travel will be Thursday, April 1, and flights should be scheduled to depart after 3:00pm.
